

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

A maximum of ten mobile food vendor licenses shall be issued by the City at any given time. If a license is issued to an applicant who fails to commence operation of as a mobile food dispenser or preparer within 60 days of the license issuance, the license shall revert to the City, upon notice to the licensee.

Licensed mobile food dispensers and preparers shall be permitted to park and operate their business only in limited authorized locations, and only at authorized times. Current authorized locations and times are as follows:

Clayton Street between County Street and Genesee Street, every Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Clayton Street between County Street and Genesee Street, the third Saturday of each month during ArtWauk, from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Clayton Street between County Street and Genesee Street, on nights when a ticketed event is being held at the Genesee Theatre, from two hours before the event to one hour after the event.

Waukegan Municipal Beach, every Friday, Saturday and Sunday except July 1st through July 3rd.

Consumers shall be provided with single service articles, such as plastic forks and paper plates, and a waste container for their disposal. All mobile food dispensers and preparers shall offer a waste container for public use that the operator shall empty at his/her own expense.

No mobile food vehicle shall be parked on the street overnight, or left unattended and unsecured at any time. Any mobile food vehicle which is found to be unattended shall be considered a public safety hazard and may be ticketed and removed at the discretion of the chief of police.

Mobile food vendor licenses are not transferrable.

All of the proprietor's activity associated with the mobile food dispenser or preparer operation must occur within the vehicle.

All signage, product and menu information must be securely attached to the mobile food vehicle.

The City of Waukegan mobile food vendor license issued pursuant to the terms of this division shall be posted conspicuously in that part of the vehicle so that it is visible to the public by sight.
