**MAYORAL EMERGENCY ORDER TO EXTEND VEHICLE STICKER EXPIRATION DATE
AND RENEWAL RATES.**

WHEREAS, On March 9, 2020, the Governor of the State of Illinois issued a Gubernatorial Disaster Proclamation with respect to the ongoing spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, On March 11, the World Health Organization categorized this outbreak of COVID-19 as a pandemic; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Gubernatorial Disaster Proclamation, I, Samuel D. Cunningham, Jr., Mayor of the City of Waukegan, issued a Mayoral Declaration of Emergency relating to this outbreak of COVID-19 on March 14, 2020, which declaration was subsequently ratified by an Ordinance adopted by the City Council of Waukegan on March 16, 2020; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to these emergency declarations, the Mayor has been granted full emergency authority provided by law, including, but not limited to, those powers designed in 65 ILCS 5/11-1-6, and the Illinois Emergency Management Act 20 ILCS 3305; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate for the City of Waukegan to immediately take all appropriate, reasonable and necessary measures available to it to protect the public's health in response to the COVID-19 outbreak; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic causes hardships for residents, and the City of Waukegan desires to provide relief in regards to the purchase and / or renewal of vehicle licenses required per City of Waukegan Code of Ordinances Chapter 21, Section VI;

THEREFORE, in further exercise of the Emergency Authority granted to me, I, Samuel D. Cunningham, Jr., Mayor of the City of Waukegan DO HEREBY ORDER as follows:

Section 1. Vehicle stickers in good standing and properly displayed on vehicles with an expiration date of April 30, 2020, will hereby be extended to a new expiration date of July 31, 2020; and furthermore, vehicle sticker "early bird" renewal rates which normally end March 31st for stickers expiring April 30th, will hereby be extended to July 31, 2020.

Section 2. This Order shall become effective at on March 21, 2020, and shall continue in effect until the City Council shall vote to lift the Declaration of Emergency or until it is

rescinded, superseded, or amended in writing by the Mayor. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the extension herein granted for vehicle sticker renewal and “early bird” rates shall not expire before July 31, 2020.

Section 3. This Order shall be promptly filed with the Clerk of the City of Waukegan, and shall be posted on the City of Waukegan’s website.

Section 4. If any provision of this Order or its application to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, then the remainder of the Order, including the application of such part or provision to other persons or circumstances, shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect. To this end, the provisions of this Order are severable.
