**CITY OF WAUKEGAN, ILLINOIS
MAYORAL EMERGENCY ORDER EXTENDING EMERGENCY AND
EXPANDING HOURS OF OUTDOOR DINING SALES**

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 Pandemic is ongoing, with more than 10,000 confirmed cases and 400 deaths in Lake County alone; and

WHEREAS, this Emergency Order should be viewed within the context of the previous 26 Emergency Orders, as well as the four prior local emergency declarations I have issued and ratified by the City Council, all of which are fully incorporated as if set forth here; and

WHEREAS, As of June 26, 2020 Lake County and the State of Illinois generally will enter Phase 4 of the State's Reopen Illinois Plan; and

WHEREAS, On May 21, 2020 I issued Mayoral Emergency Order 20-EO-22, and on May 29, 2020, I issued Order 2020-EO-23, both focused on allowing limited reopening of businesses with outdoor service. The City continues to weigh the need to assist our local bars and restaurants, while still recognizing the need for special measures to protect the public from the ongoing spread of the deadly COVID-19 Pandemic;

THEREFORE, In exercise of the Emergency Authority granted to me, by sections 65 ILCS 5/11-1-6 and 2-122 of the Waukegan Code of Ordinances, and in exercise of my powers as Local Liquor Commissioner, I, Samuel D. Cunningham, Jr., Mayor of the City of Waukegan, DO HEREBY ORDER as follows:

Section One. That the state of emergency declared by the Mayor on March 14, 2020, and extended most recently on June 1, 2020, is hereby extended, effective immediately, and that I intend to bring a formal resolution or Ordinance to the City Council for approval at the meeting scheduled on July 6, 2020 at 7:00pm, seeking ratification of this declaration and order, and seeking extension through August 4, 2020, as provided for in 65 ILCS 5/8-10-5, and other applicable laws and ordinances;

Section Two. The following Emergency Orders issued by the Mayor, except as amended by this Emergency Order 27, are ordered extended through 11:59pm on August 4, 2020, subject to ratification by the City Council at its meeting on July 6, 2020 at 7:00pm:

- 20-EO-11 Replacing EO-02, Reduced Work Schedule

All Orders not listed above shall be rescinded effective immediately, and the Clerk may remove them from the City's website provided copies are retained.

Section Three. Mayoral Emergency Order 2020-EO-23 is hereby amended by replacing Section 2, paragraph (3) to read as follows:

3) Beginning immediately, a Class A, A-1, A-2, A-3, E, or P licensee shall be authorized to sell beer, wine, or mixed alcohol drink for pick up made in conjunction with the sale and/or delivery of food or a meal to be consumed on premises, or in an outdoor area adjacent to or near the establishment during all ordinary business hours, as long as proper social distancing measures are maintained, and state and local guidance is followed.

Section Four. This Order shall become effective at 12:00 p.m. on July 2, 2020, and shall continue in effect until the City Council shall vote to lift the Declaration of Emergency or until it is rescinded, superseded, or amended in writing by the Mayor.

Section Five. This Order shall be promptly filed with the Clerk of the City of Waukegan, and shall be posted on the City of Waukegan's website.

Section Six. If any provision of this Order or its application to any person or circumstance is held to be invalid, then the remainder of the Order, including the application of such part or provision to other persons or circumstances, shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect. To this end, the provisions of this Order are severable.
